



JUAN PONCE De LEON MONUMENT

The Royal Order of Ponce De Leon Conquistadors is an organization dedicated to the preservation of the Spanish Heritage of Florida and especially Charlotte County. We have established a tax-deductible fund, protected by a surety bond to finance the creation of a monument with a bigger than life size bronze statue of Juan Ponce De Leon, who discovered Florida and Charlotte Harbor in 1513. He returned to Charlotte Harbor in 1521 and attempted to establish a colony. The monument is placed in Gilchrist Park, Punta Gorda, Florida as a prominent point of interest for residents and visitors alike.

We are soliciting your participation in this historical monument by purchasing one or more bricks for the base floor. The bricks will be inscribed with your choice of names, dates, etc.

\$100 contribution will buy one 4 x 8-inch brick inscribed with up to 14 characters or spaces on three (3) lines.

\$200 contribution will buy two 4 x 8-inch brick inscribed with up to 14 characters or spaces on six (6) lines. The two bricks will be paired.

You can use [IN HONOR OF] or [IN MEMORY OF] and that will require one line. Names and dates can be inscribed on the other lines.
